Statement Data Processing

In accordance with Articles 12 and 13 of the GDPR, we provide you with the following mandatory data protection information:

If you contact us by e-mail, we will only process your personal data if we have a legitimate interest in the processing of this data (Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. f GDPR), if you have consented to the processing of your data (Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. a GDPR), if the processing of the data is necessary for the development, Establishment, content or modification of a legal relationship between you and our company (Art. 6 Para. 1 lit. b GDPR) or if another legal provision permits the processing of this data.

Your personal data will remain in our possession until you ask us to delete this data or you revoke your consent to the storage of the data or if the purpose for which the stored data was required no longer exists (e.g. when your message has been definitively processed).

This is without prejudice to mandatory statutory provisions - in particular tax and commercial retention periods. You have the right to receive information about the origin, recipients and purpose of your archived data at any time free of charge. You also have the right to object, to transmit data and to lodge a complaint with the competent supervisory authorities. In addition, you can demand that the processing of your personal data be corrected, deleted and, under certain circumstances, restricted.

An exception to this is the use of personal data in (supplied) press releases. Here, the general journalistic interest plays a major role and you can only ask for personal data to be amended on the basis of reasonable interest. To do so, you can submit a request to:
